**Head Coach Mark Stauffer** Mark Stauffer is in his 17th year as the head women's soccer coach at Misericordia University. He has a career coaching record of 228-89-14. He has led his teams to the NCAA Division III National tournament 10 seasons while his 2012 team advanced to the NCAA National Final Four. In 2013 and 2014 they advanced to the NCAA National Sweet 16. He has been named NCAA National coach of the year and multiple times has been named the Mid-Atlantic Regional Coach of the Year.



**Head Coach Andrew Loughnane** Andrew Loughnane is the head men's soccer coach at Misericordia University. A graduate of Caldwell (NJ) University, Loughnane has spent the last five seasons as the assistant coach at the University of Scranton where he helped the Royals to a 52-27-14 record and two NCAA Tournament appearances. He was a two-time team captain at Caldwell and earned a bachelor's degree in chemistry and earned his master's degree in biochemistry from the University of Scranton.
