The transcript displays online upon successful completion of the IRS's two-step authentication.
 <u>Automated Telephone Request</u> – 1-800-908-9946. Transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the telephone request.
 <u>Paper Request Form</u> – IRS Form 4506T-EZ or IRS Form 4506-T. The transcript is generally received within 10 business days from the IRS's receipt of the paper request form. This form is used to request a Tax Return Transcript or Verification of Nonfiling.
