#### Robyn L. Fedor Stahovic

Robyn Fedor Stahovic is in her 19th season as head coach of field hockey at Misericordia where she also serves as Senior Women's Administrator.

In 2017 she guided the Cougars to their second MAC Freedom championship and NCAA Tournament appearance in the last three years.

She led MU to the MAC Freedom title game in 2013 and 2014 and an ECAC appearance in 2014.

Stahovic guided Misericordia to its winningest season ever (18-4) in 2002 and owns a career record of 163-153.

Stahovic spent 10 seasons as the MU women's lacrosse coach and led the team to Pennsylvania Athletic Conference playoff appearances in 2003, 2007 and 2008.

She was an all-conference player and a three-year starter while helping the Cougars to three consecutive PAC championships in the mid-1990s.

A graduate of Misericordia, Fedor Stahovic holds a master's degree in physical therapy.

She received the ECAC Award of Valor following her senior season and was inducted into the Plains (PA) Sports Hall of Fame in 2001.
