Registration is from **8:30 AM-9:15 AM**. This process can be time consuming so we ask that you be punctual.

Please be sure to submit all required health forms to Medicat by August 1st. These can be found on the Orientation tab on the myMU portal, **Step 3**. These forms are a mandatory requirement for all full-time students regardless of your housing status. Timely submission of your documents is vital so that preparations can be made prior to the first day of class as well as to ensure that your registration/housing process is not delayed. To access these forms, you must first register with Medicat by clicking on the Icon highlighted in yellow. You will need to make a one-time payment of \$25 and you will immediately have access to all required forms.

If you are unable to get your health physical due to insurance regulations, you can submit any completed physical done within the past 365 days. Please know however, that you will not be permitted to move on to campus or start classes until you have met these requirements. Finally, please mark your calendar for your final orientation which will be held from **August 27**rd **thru 30**th. Commuter students please know that you will be required to participate in all activities and if you have a job, be sure you plan accordingly.
