2022-23 COURSE OPTIONS

→ SCHOOL FINANCE FOR SCHOOL LEADERS 3 CREDITS

(46 PIL hours)

This course familiarizes school leaders with concepts and strategies related to school finance. The "Big Ideas" of this course focus on financial aspects of educational administration, including business-model finance strategies and forming working relationship with school business managers. This course will help increase student achievement through functional budgeting measures that provide for sufficient funds for student instruction and to meet student needs

→ COMPREHENSIVE PLANNING FOR SCHOOL LEADERS 3 CREDITS (45 PIL hours)

Participants will define and apply PA
Comprehensive Planning tools and
systems to their instructional practices.
All aspects of the defined Comprehensive
Planning process will be reviewed
including Chapter 4, Professional
Development and measures of student
growth and achievement including the
Future Ready Index and PVAAS. Emphasis
will be placed on each participant's school
entity or organization.

→ ACT 13 EDUCATOR EFFECTIVENESS MODEL: IMPLEMENTATION AND MANAGEMENT FOR SCHOOL LEADERS 3 CREDITS

(45 PIL hours)

This course allows participants to understand all elements of Act 13
Educators Effectiveness Model and Implementation while creating authentic tools to assist with Act 13 implementation and management. Big ideas include the Danielson Model, Frameworks for Observation and Practice, Performance Templates, Rating Forms and Professional Development.
