

PENNSYLVANIA STATE UNIVERSITY ARTICULATION AGREEMENT
Process for Applying to Misericordia University

There are three steps in the application process. All 3 steps must be completed in order to be considered via articulation agreement

1. **First Step**

- Student must submit **Letter of Interest** to Physical Therapy Department at Misericordia University before graduating with the Associate in Science in Physical Therapist Assistant degree.
- The Misericordia Physical Therapy Department Chair will sign the Letter of Interest and return a signed copy to the student.

2. **Second Step**

- The graduate DPT courses at MU begin in the spring. The student must submit an application to the Misericordia University Admissions Office **by April 15th** of the year before the student wishes to begin the graduate DPT program.

3. **Third Step**

- The student must submit **Notice of Application** to the Physical Therapy Department at Misericordia University by **April 15th** of the year before the student wishes to begin the graduate DPT program. **This must be sent using signature proof of delivery.** The Misericordia Physical Therapy Department Chair will sign the Notice of Application and return a signed copy to the student.
- The student is responsible for providing the following to the Physical Therapy Department at Misericordia with the application for admission:
 - a. Two letters of recommendation. One letter must be from an academic faculty member at PSU.
 - b. A plan of study explaining how any outstanding admission requirements will be met prior to the intended matriculation at MU.
